

RENEW.ORG'S LEADERSHIP ALIGNMENT TRAINING



RENEW.org's Leadership Alignment Training (LAT) is a training-mentoring program for a church's key leaders that equips them to get their church aligned around good theology and disciple making. The Leadership Alignment Training emphasizes five critical areas of leadership alignment:

MISSION ALIGNMENT 1 *Ensuring that all leaders are unified around the church's disciple-making mission.*

THEOLOGICAL ALIGNMENT 2 *Maintaining consistency in doctrinal beliefs across the leadership team to support the mission.*

PHILOSOPHICAL ALIGNMENT 3 *Harmonizing the approaches and methods used in ministry to align with the church's mission and theology.*

ORGANIZATIONAL ALIGNMENT 4 *Structuring the church's operations and leadership roles to effectively support disciple-making efforts.*

RELATIONAL ALIGNMENT 5 *Building strong, healthy relationships within the leadership team to foster trust and collaboration.*

Together, these areas create a solid foundation for moving forward in a unified disciple-making mission. You and your team will have hands-on guidance for 10 to 12 months so that you can effectively lead your congregation to live out the greatest mission on planet earth—being and making disciples of King Jesus. Other key elements of the Leadership Alignment Training include the following:

- 1 Get all key leaders not just on the same page but on the same paragraph.
- 2 Work through difficult theological and philosophical frameworks for your church as you face the future.
- 3 Access foundational tools, books, and resources to help your leaders identify and confront key cultural challenges in our day.
- 4 Access church-wide curriculum for leaders and everyday disciple makers.
- 5 Experience enhanced and sustainable growth. Your team will effectively save years on learning and growth toward a disciple-making focus, compared to churches that do not take these intentional steps for alignment.

Participants receive the **RENEW.org Training Manual**, monthly mentoring from a RENEW.org-trained, experienced lead minister/pastor, and disciple-making curriculum.
